6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 351.1015(a)(4), Tax Code, is amended to
8	read as follows:
9	(4) "Project financing zone" means an area within a
10	municipality:
11	(A) that the municipality by ordinance or by
12	agreement under Chapter 380, Local Government Code, designates as a
13	<pre>project financing zone;</pre>
14	(B) the boundaries of which are:
15	(i) within a three-mile radius of the
16	center of a qualified project; or
17	(ii) if designated by a municipality
18	described by Section 351.001(7)(B), a contiguous geographic area
19	the total area of which is less than or equal to the maximum area
20	allowed under Subparagraph (i) that contains the qualified project;
21	(C) the designation of which specifies:
22	(i) for a zone the boundaries of which are
23	<pre>prescribed by Paragraph (B)(i), the longitude and latitude of the</pre>
24	center of the qualified project; or

- 1 (ii) for a zone the boundaries of which are
- 2 prescribed by Paragraph (B)(ii), the exact boundaries of the zone;
- 3 and
- 4 (D) the designation of which expires not later
- 5 than the 30th anniversary of the date of designation.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
