## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the enforcement of certain federal laws restricting the
- 3 acquisition, manufacture, or possession of ammunition in this
- 4 state.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1.10, Penal Code, is amended by amending
- 7 Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, an agency of this state,
- 10 a political subdivision of this state, or a law enforcement officer
- 11 or other person employed by an agency of this state or a political
- 12 subdivision of this state may not contract with or in any other
- 13 manner provide assistance to a federal agency or official with
- 14 respect to the enforcement of a federal statute, order, rule, or
- 15 regulation that:
- 16 (1) imposes a prohibition, restriction, or other
- 17 regulation that does not exist under the laws of this state; and
- 18 (2) relates to:
- 19 (A) a registry requirement for a firearm, a
- 20 firearm accessory, or ammunition;
- 21 (B) a requirement that an owner of a firearm, a
- 22 firearm accessory, or ammunition possess a license as a condition
- 23 of owning, possessing, or carrying the firearm, firearm accessory,
- 24 or ammunition;

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- 1 (C) a requirement that a background check be
- 2 conducted for the private sale or transfer of a firearm, a firearm
- 3 accessory, or ammunition;
- 4 (D) a program for confiscating a firearm, a
- 5 firearm accessory, or ammunition from a person who is not otherwise
- 6 prohibited by the laws of this state from possessing the firearm,
- 7 firearm accessory, or ammunition; [ex]
- 8 (E) a program that requires an owner of a
- 9 firearm, a firearm accessory, or ammunition to sell the firearm,
- 10 firearm accessory, or ammunition;
- 11 <u>(F)</u> a limitation on the amount of ammunition that
- 12 may be purchased or otherwise obtained within a given period by a
- 13 person who is not otherwise prohibited by the laws of this state
- 14 from possessing the ammunition;
- (G) a requirement that a person obtaining
- 16 <u>ammunition display identification;</u>
- 17 (H) a limitation on the manufacture of ammunition
- 18 by a person who is not otherwise prohibited by the laws of this
- 19 state from possessing the ammunition; or
- 20 <u>(I)</u> a limitation on the purchase, sale, transfer,
- 21 or possession of components necessary to manufacture ammunition.
- 22 (c) <u>Subsections (b)(2)(A), (B), (C), (D), and (E) do</u>
- 23 [Subsection (b) does] not apply to a contract or agreement to
- 24 provide assistance in the enforcement of a federal statute, order,
- 25 rule, or regulation in effect on January 19, 2021.
- 26 (c-1) Subsections (b)(2)(F), (G), (H), and (I) do not apply
- 27 to a contract or agreement to provide assistance in the enforcement

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- 1 of a federal statute, order, rule, or regulation in effect on August
- 2 31, 2025.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
