L5	(b) The commissioners court of a county may, on the
L6	commissioners court's own motion, order a local option election in
L7	the county or a justice precinct in the county to determine whether
L8	the sale of alcoholic beverages of one or more of the various types
L9	and alcoholic contents shall be legalized in the county or the

21	(c) The governing body of a municipality may, by resolution,
22	order a local option election to be held in the municipality to
23	determine whether the sale of alcoholic beverages of one or more of
24	the various types and alcoholic contents shall be legalized in the
