AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorization by the Texas Higher Education

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 130.303(b), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The coordinating board may authorize baccalaureate
- 9 degree programs at one or more public junior colleges if the public
- 10 junior college:
- 11 (1) offers [that offer] a degree program in one of the
- 12 <u>following:</u>

- 13 (A) the field of applied science, including a
- 14 degree program in the field of applied science with an emphasis in
- 15 early childhood education, applied technology, or nursing; or
- 16 (B) the field of education; and
- 17 (2) demonstrates [have demonstrated] a workforce need
- 18 for the program.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 130.306(a), Education Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 (a) A public junior college offering a baccalaureate degree
- 22 program under this subchapter may not offer more than eight [five]
- 23 baccalaureate degree programs at any time.
- 24 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies

- 1 beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
