5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 92.056, Property Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsections $(c-1)$, $(c-2)$, and $(c-3)$ to read as follows:
8	(c-1) A landlord who receives a tenant's notice to repair or
9	remedy a condition under Subsection (b) shall acknowledge receipt
10	of the notice in writing to the tenant at the tenant's mailing
11	address not later than the second business day after the date the
12	landlord receives the notice. The acknowledgement must include a
13	statement of the tenant's rights and remedies under this section.
14	(c-2) If the tenant's notice to repair or remedy a condition
15	concerns a condition affecting a common area that is available for
16	use by more than one tenant, the landlord must acknowledge receipt
17	of the notice in writing to each tenant with access to the area at
18	the tenant's mailing address not later than the second business day
19	after the date the landlord receives the notice. The
20	acknowledgement must include a statement of the tenant's rights and
21	remedies under this section.
22	(c-3) A tenant affected by a landlord's violation of
23	Subsection (c-1) or (c-2) may obtain judicial remedies under

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
