## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to participation in the uniform group coverage program for
- 3 active school employees and additional state aid for public schools
- 4 that do not participate in that program.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1579.155, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), a [A]
- 10 participating entity that elects to discontinue participation in
- 11 the program under Subsection (a) may not elect to:
- 12 (1) participate in the program until the fifth
- 13 anniversary of the effective date of the entity's election to
- 14 discontinue participation; or
- 15 (2) discontinue the entity's participation after an
- 16 election described by Subdivision (1) until the fifth anniversary
- 17 of the effective date of that election.
- 18 (b-1) A participating entity that elected to discontinue
- 19 participation in the program between September 1, 2021, and
- 20 September 1, 2023, may elect to participate in the program before
- 21 the fifth anniversary of the effective date of that election. This
- 22 subsection expires September 1, 2030.
- SECTION 2. Effective September 1, 2027, Subchapter F,
- 24 Chapter 48, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 48.276 to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 48.276. ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR CERTAIN GROUP HEALTH
- 3 COVERAGE. (a) This section applies only to a school district or
- 4 open-enrollment charter school that does not participate in the
- 5 uniform group coverage program established under Chapter 1579,
- 6 Insurance Code.
- 7 (b) A school district or open-enrollment charter school to
- 8 which this section applies is entitled to additional state aid in an
- 9 amount equal to the product of:
- 10 <u>(1) the quotient of:</u>
- 11 (A) the amount appropriated in the General
- 12 Appropriations Act to the Teacher Retirement System of Texas for
- 13 purposes of health care for public education active employees; and
- 14 (B) the total number of employees employed by
- 15 districts and schools to which this section applies; and
- 16 (2) the number of employees employed by the district
- 17 or school.
- 18 (c) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may
- 19 use money provided under this section only to pay contributions
- 20 under a group health coverage plan for district or school
- 21 employees.
- 22 SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
