- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 526, Government Code, as
- 7 effective April 1, 2025, is amended by adding Section 526.0061 to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 526.0061. GRANT PROGRAM FOR HOSPITALS TO ASSIST WITH
- 10 CERTAIN COSTS RELATED TO CARE PROVIDED TO CHRONICALLY ILL CHILDREN.
- 11 (a) In this section:
- 12 (1) "Grant program" means the grant program for
- 13 hospitals to assist with certain costs related to care provided to
- 14 chronically ill children established under this section.
- 15 (2) "Hospital" means a hospital licensed under Chapter
- 16 241, Health and Safety Code.
- 17 (b) The executive commissioner by rule shall establish and
- 18 the commission shall administer a grant program for hospitals to
- 19 <u>assist families of chronically ill children with the costs of food</u>
- 20 and parking while a child receives health care services related to
- 21 the child's chronic illness at a hospital.
- (c) The rules adopted by the executive commissioner
- 23 establishing the grant program under this section must include
- 24 rules:

- 1 (1) prescribing eligibility criteria, application
- 2 procedures, and a scoring system for awarding grants under the
- 3 grant program to eligible hospitals; and
- 4 (2) designating the diagnoses considered chronic
- 5 illnesses for purposes of the grant program.
- 6 (d) A hospital may provide money awarded under the grant
- 7 program only:
- 8 (1) to a parent, guardian, or caretaker of a child who:
- 9 (A) is diagnosed with a chronic illness
- 10 designated by the executive commissioner; and
- 11 (B) meets the financial eligibility requirements
- 12 for Medicaid; and
- 13 (2) for the purpose of reimbursing the parent,
- 14 guardian, or caretaker for the actual costs incurred for parking at
- 15 and purchasing food from the hospital at which the chronically ill
- 16 <u>child is hospitalized or otherwise receives care for the chronic</u>
- 17 illness.
- 18 (e) The commission shall award grants as provided by this
- 19 section from available money, including money appropriated for the
- 20 purpose of the grant program.
- 21 <u>(f) The commission may accept gifts, grants, and donations</u>
- 22 from any source for the purpose of the grant program.
- 23 (g) Beginning on the first anniversary of the date a
- 24 hospital is awarded money under the grant program, the hospital
- 25 shall annually submit to the commission a written report detailing
- 26 the use of grant money the hospital received under the program and
- 27 related outcomes as determined by the executive commissioner.

- 1 (h) The commission shall review the grant program at least
- 2 once every four years and determine whether the program should be
- 3 continued or modified.
- 4 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 5 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 6 Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 7 526.0061, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
