- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.108(d), Government Code, as added by
- 6 Chapter 986 (H.B. 30), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular
- 7 Session, 2023, is redesignated as Section 552.108(c-1), Government
- 8 Code, and amended to read as follows:
- 9 $\underline{(c-1)}$ [$\frac{(d)}{d}$] The exceptions [exception] to disclosure
- 10 provided by Subsections [Subsection] (a)(2) and (b)(2) do [does]
- 11 not apply to information, records, or notations if:
- 12 (1) a person who is described by or depicted in the
- 13 information, record, or notation, other than a peace officer, is
- 14 deceased or incapacitated; or
- 15 (2) each person who is described by or depicted in the
- 16 information, record, or notation, other than a person who is
- 17 deceased or incapacitated, consents to the release of the
- 18 information, record, or notation.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 20 552.108, Government Code, apply only to a request for information
- 21 that is received by a governmental body or an officer or employee of
- 22 a governmental body on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 23 request for information that was received before the effective date
- 24 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the request

- 1 was received, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 4 over another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025,
- 5 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 6 codes.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
