- 7 (i) The <u>governor</u> [board] shall <u>appoint</u> [elect] a presiding
- 8 officer from among the directors to serve in that position for two
- 9 years. A director may serve as the presiding officer for not more
- 10 than two consecutive terms.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 9502.0301, Special District Local Laws
- 12 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- (f) Implementation of a project described by Subsection (a)
- 14 may not disrupt navigation safety or two-way traffic, as defined by
- 15 Section 66.0172, Transportation Code, in a manner that violates a
- 16 rule adopted by the board of pilot commissioners for the ports of
- 17 Harris County under Chapter 66, Transportation Code.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
