- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) In this section, "commission" means the
- 6 Health and Human Services Commission.
- 7 (b) The commission shall prepare a written report on the
- 8 time frames within which Medicaid eligibility determinations were
- 9 made based on Medicaid applications submitted to the commission
- 10 each state fiscal year beginning with the state fiscal year ending
- 11 August 31, 2018. The report must include:
- 12 (1) for each state fiscal year covered by the report:
- 13 (A) the total number of Medicaid applications
- 14 submitted to the commission;
- 15 (B) the total number of Medicaid applications the
- 16 commission approved in accordance with the time frames described by
- 17 1 T.A.C. Section 358.530(a);
- 18 (C) the total number of Medicaid applications the
- 19 commission denied in accordance with the time frames described by 1
- 20 T.A.C. Section 358.530(a) and the reason for each denial;
- 21 (D) the total number of Medicaid applications the
- 22 commission approved in a time frame that exceeded the time frames
- 23 described by 1 T.A.C. Section 358.530(a);
- 24 (E) the total number of Medicaid applications the

- 1 commission denied because the eligibility determination was not
- 2 made in accordance with the time frames described by 1 T.A.C.
- 3 Section 358.530(a);
- 4 (F) the average number of days between the date a
- 5 Medicaid application was submitted to the commission and the date
- 6 the application was approved or denied; and
- 7 (G) the median number of days between the date a
- 8 Medicaid application was submitted to the commission and the date
- 9 the application was approved or denied;
- 10 (2) the total number of Medicaid applications
- 11 submitted to the commission that are pending on the date the report
- 12 required by this subsection is prepared and, for each of those
- 13 applications, the number of days that have elapsed between the date
- 14 the application was submitted and the date the report is prepared;
- 15 and
- 16 (3) the highest number of days that elapsed between
- 17 the date a Medicaid application was submitted to the commission in
- 18 any state fiscal year and the date the application was approved or
- 19 denied.
- 20 (c) Not later than December 1, 2026, the commission shall
- 21 prepare and submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of
- 22 the house of representatives, and legislature the written report
- 23 the commission prepares under Subsection (b) of this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act expires December 31, 2026.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
