## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to tuition and fee exemptions at public institutions of

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.3531(a), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 8 education shall exempt from the payment of tuition and laboratory
- 9 fees a student enrolled in one or more courses offered as part of a
- 10 criminal justice or law enforcement curriculum [charged by the
- 11 institution for a criminal justice or law enforcement course or
- 12 courses an undergraduate student] who:
- 13 (1) is employed as a peace officer by this state or by
- 14 a political subdivision of this state;
- 15 (2) is enrolled in a criminal justice or law
- 16 enforcement-related degree program at the institution;
- 17 (3) is making satisfactory academic progress toward
- 18 the student's degree as determined by the institution; and
- 19 (4) applies for the exemption at least one week before
- 20 the last date of the institution's regular registration period for
- 21 the applicable semester or other term.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 54.3531(c), Education Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. Section 54.3531, Education Code, as amended by
- 24 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and other fees charged for

- 1 the 2025 fall semester. Tuition and other fees charged for an
- 2 academic period before that semester are governed by the law in
- 3 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 4 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
