| 16 | (A) duties that are components of a counseling |
| 17 | program developed under Section 33.005; and |
| 18 | (B) duties that are not components of a |
| 19 | counseling program described by Paragraph (A), including the |
| 20 | average number of hours spent administering or providing assistance |
| 21 | in connection with assessment instruments, except for time spent |
| 22 | interpreting data from assessment instruments; and |
| 23 | (3) the findings, conclusions, and other relevant |

3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
4 school year.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
