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5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,

7 is amended by adding Section 521.012 to read as follows:

9 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS SUPPORTING EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF

10 PUBLIC SAFETY. (a) When a person applies for an original or

11 renewal driver's license or personal identification certificate

12 under this chapter, the person may contribute \$3 or more to the

13 grant program for nonprofit organizations supporting employees of

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(b) The department shall:

Section 411.013, Government Code, is amended by 11 adding Subsections (d), (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows: 12 (d) The department shall establish and administer a grant 13 14 program for and shall disburse funds to nonprofit organizations 15 that provide support to employees of the department, including support for family members of employees of the department who have 16 17 been killed or injured in the line of duty. (e) Grant funds may be used only for: 18 19 (1) providing assistance and support to: (A) employees of the department; or 20 21 (B) family members of employees of the department 22 who have been killed or injured in the line of duty; or (2) memorial signs for employees of the department who 23 24 have been killed in the line of duty.

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(2) guidelines relating to grant amounts; and

(f) The department shall establish:

(1) grant application procedures;

- 2 (g) The nonprofit organizations supporting employees of the
- 3 Department of Public Safety account is created as a dedicated
- 4 account in the general revenue fund of the state treasury. Money in
- 5 the account may be appropriated only to the department for purposes
- 6 of the grant program established under Subsection (d). Funds
- 7 disbursed under Subsection (d) are subject to audit by the
- 8 comptroller.
- 9 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 10 a person who applies for an original or renewal driver's license,
- 11 commercial driver's license, or personal identification
- 12 certificate on or after January 1, 2026.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
