- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 707.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subdivision (4-a) to read as follows:
- 8 (4-a) "School bus infraction detection system" means a
- 9 camera system affixed to a school bus with two or more camera
- 10 sensors or computers that produce a recorded video and two or more
- 11 film or digital photographic still images for the purpose of
- 12 <u>detecting violations described by Section 545.066.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 707.020, Transportation Code, is amended
- 14 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 (a) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by
- 17 <u>Subsection (a-1)</u>, a local authority may not implement or operate a
- 18 photographic traffic signal enforcement system with respect to a
- 19 highway or street under the jurisdiction of the authority.
- 20 <u>(a-1)</u> This section does not apply to a school bus infraction
- 21 detection system installed and operated by a school district or
- 22 open-enrollment charter school in this state.
- 23 SECTION 3. Section 707.021, Transportation Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:

- Sec. 707.021. USE OF EVIDENCE FROM PHOTOGRAPHIC TRAFFIC SIGNAL ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM PROHIBITED. (a) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by Subsection (b), a local authority may not issue a civil or criminal charge or citation for an offense or violation based on a recorded image produced by a photographic traffic signal enforcement system.
- (b) This section does not apply to the issuance by a
 municipality, county, school district, or open-enrollment charter
 school of a civil or criminal charge or citation, as applicable, for
 a violation described by Section 545.066 based on the use of
 recorded image-based evidence collected from a school bus
 infraction detection system installed and operated by a school
 district or open-enrollment charter school in this state.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
