2	relating to temporarily decreasing the rate of state sales and use
3	taxes under certain circumstances.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 151.0511 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 151.0511. TEMPORARY DECREASE IN TAX RATE; CONDITIONS.
8	(a) Using any available methods and revenue estimates, the
9	<pre>comptroller shall:</pre>
10	(1) determine the amount of the ending certification
11	balance for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2025, that
12	is attributable to revenue during that state fiscal biennium from
13	the taxes imposed under this chapter;
14	(2) determine the amount, if any, of the estimated
15	ending certification balance for the state fiscal biennium ending
16	August 31, 2027, that is attributable to revenue during that state
17	fiscal biennium from the taxes imposed under this chapter if those
18	taxes are imposed at the tax rate provided by Section 151.051(b);
19	<u>and</u>
20	(3) if the amount determined under Subdivision (2) is
21	more than 50 percent of the amount determined under Subdivision
22	<u>(1):</u>

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for the tax rate described by Subdivision (2), results in the amount

(A) determine the tax rate that, when substituted

- 1 determined under Subdivision (2) equaling 50 percent of the amount
- 2 determined under Subdivision (1); and
- 3 (B) publish the tax rate determined under
- 4 Paragraph (A) in the Texas Register and on the comptroller's
- 5 Internet website and provide notice of that tax rate to sales tax
- 6 permit holders.
- 7 (b) If the condition provided by Subsection (a)(3) is
- 8 satisfied, the rate of the sales tax and use tax under this chapter
- 9 applicable in the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2027, is
- 10 the rate determined under Subsection (a)(3)(A), notwithstanding
- 11 Section 151.051(b).
- 12 (c) This section expires December 1, 2027.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
