SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 361.1201 to read as follows:

Sec. 361.1201. CANCELLATION OF CERTAIN LANDFILL PERMITS. This section applies only to a facility that is located in:

(1) a county with a population of more than

million; and

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(2) the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the county's principal municipality with a population of more than 900,000.

(b) The commission shall cancel a permit issued for a

municipal solid waste landfill facility if the facility has not

accepted waste for a period of 25 consecutive years.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-36 1-37 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 1-39

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
