## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 32.02473 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 32.02473. EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
8	FOR CERTAIN WOMEN OF REPRODUCTIVE AGE. (a) Notwithstanding any
9	other law, the commission shall provide medical assistance to each
10	woman in this state:
11	(1) who is of reproductive age, including each woman
12	who is at least 19 years of age or older but younger than 50 years of
13	age;
14	(2) who has a household income that is at or below 133
15	percent of the federal poverty level;
16	(3) who applies for the assistance; and
17	(4) for whom federal matching money is available

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- (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary 18
- to implement this section. 19
- SECTION 2. Section 32.02473, Human Resources Code, as added 20
- 21 by this Act, applies only to an initial determination or
- recertification of eligibility of an individual for medical 22
- assistance under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, made on or after 23
- the date the section is implemented, regardless of the date the 24

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- 1 individual applied for that assistance.
- 2 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 3 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 4 Services Commission shall take all necessary actions to expand
- 5 eligibility for medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human
- 6 Resources Code, in accordance with Section 32.02473, Human
- 7 Resources Code, as added by this Act, including notifying
- 8 appropriate federal agencies of that expanded eligibility.
- 9 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 10 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 11 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 12 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 13 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 14 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
