A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prosecution of the offense of sexual assault.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 22.011(b), Penal Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) A sexual assault under Subsection (a)(1) is without the
- 7 consent of the other person if:
- 8 (1) the actor compels the other person to submit or
- 9 participate by the use of physical force, violence, or coercion;
- 10 (2) the actor compels the other person to submit or
- 11 participate by threatening to use force or violence against the
- 12 other person or to cause harm to the other person, and the other
- 13 person believes that the actor has the present ability to execute
- 14 the threat;
- 15 (3) [the other person has not consented and] the actor
- 16 knows the other person is unconscious, [ex] physically unable to
- 17 resist, or unaware that the sexual assault is occurring;
- 18 (4) the actor knows that as a result of mental disease
- 19 or defect the other person is at the time of the sexual assault
- 20 incapable either of appraising the nature of the act or of resisting
- 21 it;
- 22 (5) the actor knows the other person has withdrawn
- 23 consent to the act and the actor persists in the act [the other
- 24 person has not consented and the actor knows the other person is

1 unaware that the sexual assault is occurring];

- 2 (6) the actor knows or reasonably should know that the
- 3 other person cannot consent because of intoxication or impairment
- 4 by any substance [the actor has intentionally impaired the other
- 5 person's power to appraise or control the other person's conduct by
- 6 administering any substance without the other person's knowledge];
- 7 (7) the actor compels the other person to submit or
- 8 participate by threatening to use force or violence against any
- 9 person, and the other person believes that the actor has the ability
- 10 to execute the threat;
- 11 (8) the actor is a public servant who coerces the other
- 12 person to submit or participate;
- 13 (9) the actor is a mental health services provider or a
- 14 health care services provider who causes the other person, who is a
- 15 patient or former patient of the actor, to submit or participate by
- 16 exploiting the other person's emotional dependency on the actor;
- 17 (10) the actor is a clergyman who causes the other
- 18 person to submit or participate by exploiting the other person's
- 19 emotional dependency on the clergyman in the clergyman's
- 20 professional character as spiritual adviser;
- 21 (11) the actor is an employee of a facility where the
- 22 other person is a resident, unless the employee and resident are
- 23 formally or informally married to each other under Chapter 2,
- 24 Family Code;
- 25 (12) the actor is a health care services provider who,
- 26 in the course of performing an assisted reproduction procedure on
- 27 the other person, uses human reproductive material from a donor

- 1 knowing that the other person has not expressly consented to the use
- 2 of material from that donor;
- 3 (13) the actor is a coach or tutor who causes the other
- 4 person to submit or participate by using the actor's power or
- 5 influence to exploit the other person's dependency on the actor; or
- 6 (14) the actor is a caregiver hired to assist the other
- 7 person with activities of daily life and causes the other person to
- 8 submit or participate by exploiting the other person's dependency
- 9 on the actor.
- SECTION 2. Section 22.011(c), Penal Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as follows:
- 12 (1-a) "Consent" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 13 <u>1.</u>07.
- 14 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 19 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 21 before that date.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
