H.B. No. 3080

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to funding for roadways and transportation facilities that enable monitoring of commercial motor vehicles in the border 3 4 region. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 421, Government Code, is amended by 7 adding Subchapter G to read as follows: SUBCHAPTER G. USE OF FUNDS FOR MONITORING COMMERCIAL MOTOR 8 9 VEHICLES IN THE BORDER REGION Sec. 421.111. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 10 11 (1) "Border region" has the meaning assigned by 12 Section 772.0071. (2) "Local government" means a municipality or county. 13 14 (3) "Office" means the trusteed programs within the office of the governor. 15 16 Sec. 421.112. USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS. From money appropriated for that purpose, the office, as authorized by Chapter 17 418, including Subchapter D of that chapter, shall make funds 18 available to state agencies and local governments for the 19 construction or improvement of roadways and similar transportation 20 facilities in the border region that provide for detailed 21 monitoring of commercial motor vehicles traveling along the 22 23 roadways and facilities. 24 Sec. 421.113. FEDERAL FUNDS; GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS.

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1	In addition to funds appropriated by the legislature and for
2	purposes of this subchapter, the office may:
3	(1) seek and apply for any available federal funds;
4	and
5	(2) solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations
6	from any other source, public or private.
7	Sec. 421.114. RULES. The office may adopt rules for the
8	administration of this subchapter.
9	Sec. 421.115. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. (a) The recipient
10	of funds under Section 421.112 shall submit to the office reports on
11	an interval prescribed by the office regarding the use of the funds
12	and any other issue related to the funds as determined by the
13	office.
14	(b) Funds received by a state agency under Section 421.112
15	are considered border security funding for purposes of reporting
16	requirements in the General Appropriations Act.
17	Sec. 421.116. ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. Unless otherwise
18	provided by the appropriation, the office may use a reasonable
19	amount, not to exceed five percent, of any general revenue
20	appropriated for purposes of this subchapter to pay the costs of
21	administering this subchapter.
22	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
23	of this Act, the office of the governor shall adopt rules as

of this Act, the office of the governor shall adopt rules as necessary to implement Subchapter G, Chapter 421, Government Code, as added by this Act.

26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
