2	relating to the regulation by the Railroad Commission of Texas of
3	injection wells used to dispose of oil and gas waste; authorizing a
4	fee.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 27.031, Water Code, is amended to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 27.031. PERMIT FROM RAILROAD COMMISSION; REPORT. (a)
9	No person may continue using a disposal well or begin drilling a
10	disposal well or converting an existing well into a disposal well to
11	dispose of oil and gas waste without first obtaining a permit from
12	the railroad commission.
13	(b) The railroad commission shall require a permit holder to
14	provide the commission with a daily report regarding:
15	(1) the amount of produced water injected into the
16	disposal well; and
17	(2) the surface injection pressure data taken from the
18	disposal well.
19	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 27, Water Code, is amended
20	by adding Sections 27.0311 and 27.038 to read as follows:
21	Sec. 27.0311. FEE. (a) For each injection well issued a
22	permit, the railroad commission shall impose a fee of:
23	(1) one cent per barrel of oil and gas waste injected
24	if the oil and gas waste is produced within the commission oil and

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1	gas division district in which the injection well is located; or
2	(2) ten cents per barrel of oil and gas waste injected
3	if the oil and gas waste is not produced within the commission oil
4	and gas division district in which the injection well is located.
5	(b) A fee collected under Subsection (a) shall be deposited
6	in the injection and abandoned wells cleanup fund under Section
7	27.038.
8	Sec. 27.038. INJECTION AND ABANDONED WELLS CLEANUP FUND.
9	(a) The injection and abandoned wells cleanup fund is created as an
10	account in the general revenue fund of the state treasury.
11	(b) The fund consists of fees collected under Section
12	<u>27.0311.</u>
13	(c) Money in the injection and abandoned wells cleanup fund
14	may be used by the railroad commission or its employees or agents
15	only to fund projects related to researching:
16	(1) the reuse and treatment for reuse of produced
17	water; and
18	(2) the surface remediation and plugging of abandoned
19	wells.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
