- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.052(c), Utilities Code, is amended to

- 7 (c) An electric utility is not required to amend the
- 8 utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity to
- 9 construct a transmission line that connects the utility's existing
- 10 transmission facilities to a substation or metering point if:
- 11 (1) the transmission line does not exceed:
- 12 (A) five [three] miles in length, if the line
- 13 connects to a load-serving substation or metering point; or
- 14 (B) two miles in length, if the line connects to a
- 15 generation substation or metering point;
- 16 (2) each landowner whose property would be directly
- 17 affected by the transmission line, as provided by commission rules,
- 18 provides written consent for the transmission line; and
- 19 (3) all rights-of-way necessary for construction of
- 20 the transmission line have been purchased.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
