A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a certificate of public convenience and necessity to 3 construct an electric transmission line. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.052(c), Utilities Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (c) An electric utility is not required to amend the utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity to 8 construct a transmission line that connects the utility's existing 9 transmission facilities to a substation or metering point if: 10 11 (1) the transmission line does not exceed: 12 (A) five [three] miles in length, if the line connects to a load-serving substation or metering point; or 13 14 (B) two miles in length, if the line connects to a generation substation or metering point; 15 16 (2) each landowner whose property would be directly affected by the transmission line, as provided by commission rules, 17 provides written consent for the transmission line; and 18 (3) all rights-of-way necessary for construction of 19 20 the transmission line have been purchased. 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
