18	(A) an established health care provider group; or

23	(2) be a Medicaid-enrolled provider;		
24	(3) agree to comply with the terms of the contract

- 3 Medicaid managed care organization requires as necessary to enable
- 4 the organization to begin the credentialing process the
- 5 organization requires to include a provider in the organization's

- 7 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 8 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 9 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 10 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 11 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 12 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
