## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the participation of optometrists and therapeutic
3	optometrists in managed care plans providing vision benefits.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1451, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1451.1545 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1451.1545. PARTICIPATION IN VISION CARE PLAN; EFFECT
8	ON OTHER PLANS. (a) In this section, "vision care plan" has the
9	meaning assigned by Section 1451.157(a).
10	(b) A vision care plan issuer must include on the issuer's
11	<pre>Internet website a method for a licensed optometrist or therapeutic</pre>
12	optometrist to submit an application for inclusion as a
13	participating provider in the plan. The application:
14	(1) may only require an applicant to provide:
15	(A) standardized information prescribed by rules
16	adopted under Section 1452.052 that is applicable to an optometrist
17	or therapeutic optometrist; or
18	(B) information available from the Council for
19	Affordable Quality Healthcare; and
20	(2) must impose the same requirements on each
21	optometrist and therapeutic optometrist.
22	(c) A vision care plan issuer shall:

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issuer receives an application described by Subsection (b) that

- 1 meets the plan's credentialing requirements, electronically
- 2 deliver to the applicant a participating provider contract,
- 3 <u>including applicable reimbursement fee schedules, provider</u>
- 4 handbooks, and provider manuals; and
- 5 (2) not later than the 20th business day after the date
- 6 the applicant accepts the contract, include the applicant as a
- 7 participating provider in the plan.
- 8 <u>(d) A vision care plan issuer must allow an optometrist or</u>
- 9 therapeutic optometrist to be a participating provider to the full
- 10 extent of the optometrist's or therapeutic optometrist's license on
- 11 all of the issuer's:
- 12 <u>(1) vision care plans and other managed care plans</u>
- 13 with vision benefits that have enrollees located in this state; and
- 14 (2) vision panels, as defined by Section 1451.154.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 1451.157(a)(2), Insurance Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (2) "Vision care plan" means a managed care plan that:
- 18 (A) is offered in the form of a limited-scope
- 19 policy, agreement, contract, or evidence of coverage; and
- 20 (B) [that] provides coverage for eye care
- 21 expenses but does not provide comprehensive medical coverage.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 a contract between a vision care plan issuer and an optometrist or
- 24 therapeutic optometrist entered into or renewed on or after the
- 25 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
