| 8 | IVERMECTIN. (a) The commissioner shall issue a statewide order     |
| 9 | authorizing a licensed pharmacist to dispense ivermectin without a |

  10 <u>health care practitioner's prescription order notwithstanding any</u>
  11 <u>other law.</u>
- 12 <u>(b) The statewide order must include written, standardized</u>
  13 procedures or protocols for a pharmacist to follow when dispensing
  14 ivermectin and require the pharmacist to provide each patient with
  15 instructions on the proper use of ivermectin.
- 16 <u>(c) Notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacist may</u>
  17 dispense ivermectin in accordance with the statewide order.
- 18 (d) Except for wilful misconduct or gross negligence and
  19 notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacist acting in good faith is
  20 not criminally or civilly liable or subject to professional
  21 disciplinary action for dispensing ivermectin in accordance with
  22 the statewide order.
- (e) A pharmacist dispensing ivermectin in accordance with the statewide order shall provide an annual written report in the

- 1 form and manner the department prescribes on the number of doses of
- 2 ivermectin the pharmacist dispensed in accordance with the
- 3 statewide order <u>in the preceding calendar year.</u>
- 4 (f) The executive commissioner and the Texas State Board of
- 5 Pharmacy may adopt the rules necessary to implement this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 7 of this Act, the commissioner of state health services shall issue a
- 8 statewide order in accordance with Section 1001.090, Health and
- 9 Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
