- 2 relating to the establishment of the Texas geothermal energy
- 3 production policy council.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 81, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 81.076 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 81.076. TEXAS GEOTHERMAL ENERGY PRODUCTION POLICY
- 8 COUNCIL. (a) In this section, "council" means the Texas geothermal
- 9 energy production policy council.
- 10 (b) The Texas geothermal energy production policy council
- 11 is established within the commission to study and make
- 12 recommendations relating to the commission's policy framework for
- 13 geothermal energy development.
- 14 (c) The council is composed of:
- 15 (1) the chair of the commission or the chair's
- 16 designee;
- 17 (2) the director of the Bureau of Economic Geology of
- 18 The University of Texas at Austin or the director's designee; and
- 19 (3) not more than 11 members appointed by the
- 20 commission to represent as many different types of participants as
- 21 possible, including at least three but not more than five
- 22 representatives from the geothermal energy industry.
- 23 (d) The chair of the commission or the chair of the
- 24 commission's designee is the chair of the council.

- 1 (e) A member of the council is not entitled to compensation
- 2 or reimbursement of expenses for service on the council.
- 3 <u>(f) The council shall:</u>
- 4 (1) study the development of geothermal energy
- 5 industries in this state, including the development of facilities
- 6 for the production, pipeline transportation, and storage of
- 7 geothermal energy;
- 8 (2) analyze how tax incentives or cooperation with the
- 9 Geothermal Technologies Office of the United States Department of
- 10 Energy could encourage the development of geothermal energy
- 11 projects in this state; and
- 12 (3) develop a state plan for geothermal energy
- 13 production oversight by the commission.
- 14 (g) The council shall make recommendations to the
- 15 legislature relating to legislative changes needed for the
- 16 oversight and regulation of production, pipeline transportation,
- 17 and storage of geothermal energy.
- 18 (h) The council is abolished and this section expires
- 19 January 1, 2032.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
