A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to electronic voter registration.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 13.009. ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION. (a) The
7	secretary of state shall work with the Department of Public Safety
8	and the Department of Information Resources to implement a program
9	to allow a person to complete a voter registration application over
10	the Internet from the official website of this state. The Internet
11	websites of the secretary of state and the Department of Public
12	Safety must also provide a link to the location of the application
13	on the official website of this state.
14	(b) An applicant for electronic voter registration who has
15	an unexpired driver's license or personal identification card
16	<pre>issued in this state must:</pre>
17	(1) attest to the truth of the information provided on
18	the application by affirmatively accepting the information as true;
19	<u>and</u>
20	(2) affirmatively consent to the use of the signature
21	on the applicant's driver's license or personal identification card
22	for voter registration purposes.
23	(c) An applicant for electronic voter registration who does

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not have an unexpired driver's license or personal identification

- 1 card issued in this state must:
- 2 (1) attest to the truth of the information provided on
- 3 the application by affirmatively accepting the information as true;
- 4 and
- 5 (2) digitally sign the applicant's application before
- 6 <u>submitting it electronically.</u>
- 7 (d) For each application submitted under Subsection (b),
- 8 the program shall require that a digital copy of the applicant's
- 9 signature be obtained from the Department of Public Safety.
- 10 (e) A digital signature given as provided by secretary of
- 11 <u>state rule meets the signature requirement under Section 13.002(b).</u>
- 12 An application submitted under this section is considered for all
- 13 purposes an application submitted by mail under this title.
- 14 (f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 15 implement this section, including rules to provide for additional
- 16 security measures necessary to ensure the accuracy and integrity of
- 17 applications submitted electronically.
- 18 (g) The rules adopted under Subsection (f) must require
- 19 that:
- 20 (1) the Internet website through which a person may
- 21 complete a voter registration application include a description of
- 22 the offense described by Section 13.007 in a conspicuous location
- 23 on the website near the place where the person begins or submits the
- 24 application; and
- 25 (2) the state electronic Internet portal project be
- 26 used to authenticate the identity and address of a person who
- 27 submits an application electronically under this section.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 13.042(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (c) An application submitted after the 27th [34th] day
- 4 before the date of an election and on or before the last day for a
- 5 person to timely submit a registration application for that
- 6 election as provided by Section 13.143 shall be delivered not later
- 7 than 5 p.m. of the next regular business day after the date to
- 8 timely submit a registration application for that election as
- 9 provided by Section 13.143.
- SECTION 3. Sections 13.143(a) and (e), Election Code, are
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and (e), if an
- 13 applicant's registration application is approved, the registration
- 14 becomes effective on the 23rd [30th] day after the date the
- 15 application is submitted to the registrar or on the date the
- 16 applicant becomes 18 years of age, whichever is later.
- 17 (e) If the 23rd [30th] day before the date of an election is
- 18 a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, an
- 19 application is considered to be timely if it is submitted to the
- 20 registrar on or before the next regular business day.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
