4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 130.912, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsections (d), (e), and (g) and adding
7	Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
8	(d) The comptroller shall award a grant to a qualified
9	county that applies for the grant using money appropriated to the
10	comptroller for that purpose. The grant must be in the following
11	applicable amount:
12	(1) \$75,000 for each constable precinct in the county
13	if the county has a population of less than 10,000;
14	(2) \$100,000 for each constable precinct in the county
15	if the county has a population of 10,000 or more and less than
16	50,000; and
17	(3) \$150,000 for each constable precinct in the county
18	if the county has a population of 50,000 or more and 300,000 or less
19	[The comptroller may only award a grant to a county if the county
20	agrees in writing to contribute at least 75 percent of the money
21	required to meet the minimum annual salary requirement established
22	under Subsection (e) for each qualified constable for which the
23	county will also use grant money to provide that salary].
24	(e) <u>A</u> [ <del>Subject to Subsection (d), a</del> ] county that is awarded

No. 3253 1 a grant shall use or authorize the use of the grant money only: 2 (1) to provide a minimum annual salary of <u>at least</u>: (A) \$65,000 for the [\$45,000 to a qualified] 3 constable of each precinct; and 4 (B) \$45,000 for each deputy constable who makes 5 6 motor vehicle stops in the routine performance of the deputy 7 constable's duties; 8 (2) to increase the salary of a person described by Subdivision (1); 9 10 (3) to hire additional deputies or staff for the constable's office; or 11 12 (4) to purchase vehicles, firearms, and safety equipment for the constable's office. 13 14 (e-1) A county that is awarded a grant may not use or 15 authorize the use of the grant money for a purpose other than to meet the minimum salary requirements prescribed by Subsection 16 17 (e)(1) until those requirements are satisfied. The comptroller shall adopt rules 18 (g) necessary to implement this section, including rules that establish: 19 20 (1) a standardized application process, including the form to be used to apply for a grant and the manner of submitting the 21 22 form; (2) deadlines for: 23 24 (A) applying for the grant; 25 disbursement of grant money; and (B) 26 (C) spending grant money; and 27 (3) procedures for:

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(A) monitoring the disbursement of grant money to
 ensure compliance with this section; and

3 (B) the return of grant money that was not used by
4 a county for a purpose authorized by this section[; and

5 [(4) standards to determine if a constable is a 6 qualified constable].

7 SECTION 2. Section 130.912(a)(2), Local Government Code, is
8 repealed.

9 SECTION 3. Section 130.912, Local Government Code, as 10 amended by this Act, applies only to the award of a grant to a county 11 under the rural constable's office salary assistance grant program 12 during a fiscal year of the county that begins on or after the 13 effective date of this Act.

14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
