4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by

- 7 <u>(u) In addition to any other essential knowledge and skills</u> 8 the State Board of Education adopts for the health curriculum under
- 9 Subsection (a)(2)(B), the board shall adopt for the health
- 10 curriculum essential knowledge and skills that address topics
- 11 relating to firearm safety that:
- 12 (1) focus on accident prevention;

adding Subsection (u) to read as follows:

- 13 (2) promote the safety and protection of students; and
- 14 (3) emphasize how students should respond when
- 15 encountering a firearm.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 17 school year.

- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
