1	AN ACT
2	relating to the operation of an unmanned aircraft over a spaceport;
3	creating a criminal offense.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 42.15, Penal Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 42.15. OPERATION OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT OVER AIRPORT <u>,</u>
8	[OR] MILITARY INSTALLATION, OR SPACEPORT.
9	SECTION 2. Section 42.15(a), Penal Code, is amended by
10	adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
11	(3) "Spaceport" means any property or facility that
12	is:
13	(A) used for the launch, landing, or recovery of
14	spacecraft, as defined by Section 507.001, Local Government Code;
15	and
16	(B) licensed by the Federal Aviation
17	Administration or operated by a spaceport development corporation
18	under Chapter 507, Local Government Code.
19	SECTION 3. Sections 42.15(b) and (c), Penal Code, are
20	amended to read as follows:
21	(b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
22	or knowingly:
23	(1) operates an unmanned aircraft over an airport <u>,</u>
24	[or] military installation <u>, or spaceport</u> ;

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(2) allows an unmanned aircraft to make contact with an airport, [or] military installation, <u>or spaceport</u>, including any person or object on the premises of or within the airport, [or] military installation, <u>or spaceport</u>; or

5 (3) operates an unmanned aircraft in a manner that 6 interferes with the operations of or causes a disturbance to an 7 airport, [or] military installation, or spaceport.

8 (c) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that 9 the conduct described by Subsection (b) was engaged in by:

10 (1) the federal government, this state, or a 11 governmental entity;

12 (2) a person under contract with or otherwise acting 13 under the direction or on behalf of the federal government, this 14 state, or a governmental entity;

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(3) a law enforcement agency;

16 (4) a person under contract with or otherwise acting 17 under the direction or on behalf of a law enforcement agency;

18 (5) an owner or operator of the airport, [or] military
19 installation, or spaceport;

(6) a person under contract with or otherwise acting
under the direction or on behalf of an owner or operator of the
airport, [or] military installation, or spaceport;

(7) a person who has the prior written or electronicauthorization of:

(A) the owner or operator of the airport, [or]
military installation, or spaceport; or

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(B) the Federal Aviation Administration; or

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(8) the owner or occupant of the property on which the
 airport, [or] military installation, or spaceport is located or a
 person who has the prior written consent of the owner or occupant of
 that property.

SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 5 6 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 7 8 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 9 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 10 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 11 before that date. 12

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
