Section 162.001, Property Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 6 (a-1) Except as provided by this subsection, funds reserved or required to be reserved under Section 53.101 are trust funds 7 under this chapter. Funds reserved or required to be reserved under 8 9 Section 53.101 for the construction or repair of a new or existing single-family house, duplex, triplex, or quadruplex, to be used for 10 residential purposes, including improvements appurtenant to the 11 residence, are not trust funds under this chapter. 12 SECTION 2. Section 162.003(a), Property Code, is amended to 13 14 read as follows: mechanic, artisan, laborer, 15 (a) An contractor, 16 subcontractor, or materialman who labors or who furnishes labor or material for the construction or repair of an improvement on 17 specific real property in this state is a beneficiary of any trust 18 19 funds: 20 (1) paid in or received connection with the 21 improvement; or 22 (2) reserved or required to be reserved under Section 23 53.101 in connection with the improvement. 24 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 162, Property Code, is

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1 amended by adding Section 162.034 to read as follows:

Sec. 162.034. ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS. The court shall
award costs and reasonable attorney's fees to a beneficiary who
prevails in an action brought against a trustee under this chapter.

5 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this 6 section, the changes in law made by this Act apply only to a 7 construction contract that is entered into on or after the 8 effective date of this Act.

9 (b) Section 162.034, Property Code, as added by this Act, 10 applies only to an action commenced on or after the effective date 11 of this Act.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
