1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of the Texas prekindergarten fund to
3	support public school prekindergarten education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 29.1555 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 29.1555. TEXAS PREKINDERGARTEN FUND. (a) In this
8	section, "fund" means the Texas prekindergarten fund established
9	under this section.
10	(b) The Texas prekindergarten fund is a dedicated account in
11	the general revenue fund.
12	(c) The fund consists of:
13	(1) money appropriated or transferred to the fund;
14	(2) any revenue that by law is dedicated for deposit to
15	the credit of the fund;
16	(3) interest and investment earnings on money in the
17	fund; and
18	(4) money from gifts, grants, or donations to the
19	<u>fund.</u>
20	(d) Money in the fund may be used only to:
21	(1) expand access to high quality prekindergarten
22	programs for eligible children;
23	(2) provide financial assistance to school districts
24	and open-enrollment charter schools that offer prekindergarten;

1	(3) support professional development and training for
2	teachers who teach prekindergarten; and
3	(4) enhance facilities and instructional resources
4	for prekindergarten programs.
5	(e) The agency shall allocate money appropriated from the
6	<pre>fund to school districts and open-enrollment charter schools:</pre>
7	(1) based on:
8	(A) the percentage of educationally
9	disadvantaged students enrolled in the district or school;
10	(B) geographic and demographic needs at the
11	district or school; and
12	(C) the district's or school's compliance with
13	the standards for high quality prekindergarten programs under
14	Subchapter E-1; and
15	(2) prioritizing districts and schools that:
16	(A) serve low-income families;
17	(B) serve rural and underserved communities; or
18	(C) offer a prekindergarten program that
19	demonstrates high performance in early childhood education
20	outcomes.
21	(f) Not later than September 1 of each year, the agency
22	shall submit to the governor and the legislature a report on:
23	(1) the distribution of money appropriated from the
24	fund during the preceding school year;
25	(2) the impact of prekindergarten programs that
26	received money appropriated from the fund on student performance
27	during the preceding school year; and

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- 1 (3) recommendations for legislative or other action.
- 2 <u>(g)</u> The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 3 <u>implement this section</u>.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
