4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 355.102(d) and (e), Estates Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(d) Class 3 claims are composed of claims:
8	(1) for the principal amount of and accrued interest
9	on delinquent child support and child support arrearages that have
10	been:
11	(A) confirmed as a judgment or a determination of
12	arrearages by a court under Title 5, Family Code; or
13	(B) administratively determined as evidenced by
14	a certified child support payment record produced by the Title IV-I
15	agency, as defined by Section 101.033, Family Code, in a Title IV-I
16	case, as defined by Section 101.034, Family Code; and
17	(2) for unpaid child support obligations under Section
18	154.015, Family Code [each secured claim for money under Section
19	355.151(a)(1), including a tax lien, to the extent the claim can be
20	paid out of the proceeds of the property subject to the mortgage or
21	other lien. If more than one mortgage, lien, or security interest
22	exists on the same property, the claims shall be paid in order of
23	priority of the mortgage, lien, or security interest securing the
24	debt].

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(e) Class 4 claims are composed of <u>each secured claim for</u> 1 money under Section 355.151(a)(1), including a tax lien, to the 2 extent the claim can be paid out of the proceeds of the property 3 subject to the mortgage or other lien. If more than one mortgage, 4 lien, or security interest exists on the same property, the claims 5 shall be paid in order of priority of the mortgage, lien, or 6 7 security interest securing the debt [claims: 8 [(1) for the principal amount of and accrued interest on delinquent child support and child support arrearages that have 9 10 been: [(A) confirmed as a judgment or a determination 11 of arrearages by a court under Title 5, Family Code; or 12 [(B) administratively determined as evidenced by 13 14 a certified child support payment record produced by the Title IV-D 15 agency, as defined by Section 101.033, Family Code, in a Title IV-D case, as defined by Section 101.034, Family Code; and 16 17 [(2) for unpaid child support obliquations under Section 154.015, Family Code]. 18 SECTION 2. Sections 355.102(d) and (e), Estates Code, as 19 amended by this Act, apply only to the estate of a decedent who dies 20 on or after the effective date of this Act. The estate of a decedent 21 who dies before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 22
