- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 7
- SECTION 1. Section 15.431(a)(1), Water Code, is amended to 8
- read as follows: 9
- (1) "Advisory committee" means the [State Water 10
- 11 Implementation Fund for Texas Water Fund Advisory Committee.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 15.438, Water Code, is transferred to
- Subchapter A, Chapter 15, Water Code, redesignated as Section 13
- 14 15.009, Water Code, and amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 15.009 [<del>15.438</del>]. TEXAS WATER FUND ADVISORY 15
- COMMITTEE. (a) The [State Water Implementation Fund for] Texas 16
- Water Fund Advisory Committee is composed of the following eight 17
- [seven] members: 18
- (1) the comptroller, or a person designated by the 19
- 20 comptroller;
- 21 the chair of the committee of the senate having
- 22 primary jurisdiction over water resources;
- 23 (3) the chair of the committee of the house of
- 24 representatives having primary jurisdiction over water resources;

(4) two [three] members of the senate appointed by the 1 lieutenant governor, including at least one [+ 2  $\left[\frac{A}{A}\right]$  member of the committee of the senate 3 having primary jurisdiction over matters relating to finance; 4 5 (5) two [and 6 [(B) the chair of the committee of the senate 7 having primary jurisdiction over water resources; and 8 [<del>(3) three</del>] members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, including 9 10 at least one[+  $\left[\frac{A}{A}\right]$  member of the committee of the house of 11 12 representatives having primary jurisdiction over appropriations; 13 and 14 (6) the director of the Texas Division of Emergency 15 Management or the successor in function to that entity, or a person designated by that person, who serves as a nonvoting member 16 [(B) the chair of the committee of the house of 17 representatives having primary jurisdiction over water resources]. 18 19 The following persons shall serve as staff support for the advisory committee: 20 21 the deputy executive administrator of the board who is responsible for water science and conservation or a person 22 who holds an equivalent position at the agency, or a person 23 24 designated by that person; 25 (2) the deputy executive administrator of the board 26 who is responsible for water resources planning and information or a person who holds an equivalent position at the agency, or a person 27

- 1 designated by that person; and
- 2 (3) the chief financial officer of the board, or a
- 3 person who holds an equivalent position at the agency.
- 4 (c) A [An appointed] member of the advisory committee
- 5 designated under Subsection (a)(1) or (6) or appointed under
- 6 Subsection (a)(4) or (5) serves at the will of the person who
- 7 <u>designated or</u> appointed the member.
- 8 (d) The members of the advisory committee described by
- 9 Subsections (a)(2) and (3) serve as [lieutenant governor shall
- 10 appoint a co-presiding officers [officer] of the [advisory]
- 11 committee [from among the members appointed by the lieutenant
- 12 governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives shall
- 13 appoint a co-presiding officer of the committee from among the
- 14 members appointed by the speaker].
- 15 (e) The advisory committee may hold public hearings, formal
- 16 meetings, or work sessions. Either co-presiding officer of the
- 17 advisory committee may call a public hearing, formal meeting, or

- 20 meeting, or work session unless a quorum of the committee is

- 26 of the committee. Service on the advisory committee by a member of
- 27 the senate or house of representatives is considered legislative

- 1 service for which the member is entitled to reimbursement and other
- 2 benefits in the same manner and to the same extent as for other
- 3 legislative service.
- 4 (g) As needed, the [The] advisory committee shall submit
- 5 comments and recommendations to the board regarding the use of
- 6 money in:
- 7 (1) the state water implementation fund for Texas
- 8  $\underline{\text{established under Subchapter G}}$  [ $\underline{\text{fund}}$ ] for use by the board in
- 9 adopting rules under Section 15.439 and in adopting policies and
- 10 procedures under Section 15.441;
- 11 (2) the Texas water fund established under Subchapter
- 12 H-1 for use by the board in adopting rules under Section 15.507;
- 13 (3) the flood infrastructure fund established under
- 14 Subchapter I for use by the board in adopting rules under Section
- 15 <u>15.537</u>; and
- 16 (4) the Texas infrastructure resiliency fund
- 17 established under Section 16.452 for use by the board in adopting
- 18 rules under Section 16.460. [The submission must include:
- 19 [(1) comments and recommendations on rulemaking
- 20 related to the prioritization of projects in regional water plans
- 21 and the state water plan in accordance with Section 15.437;
- [(2) comments and recommendations on rulemaking
- 23 related to establishing standards for determining whether projects
- 24 meet the criteria provided by Section 15.434(b);
- 25 [(3) an evaluation of the available programs for
- 26 providing financing for projects included in the state water plan
- 27 and quidelines for implementing those programs, including

- quidelines for providing financing for projects included in the 1 state water plan that are authorized under Subchapter Q or R of this 2 chapter, Subchapter E or F, Chapter 16, or Subchapter J, Chapter 17; 3 4 [(4) an evaluation of the lending practices of the 5 board and quidelines for lending standards; [(5) an evaluation of the use of funds by the board to 6 provide support for financial assistance for water projects, 7 8 including support for the purposes described by Section 15.435(c);
- 9 [(6) an evaluation of whether premium financing
  10 programs should be established within the funds described by
  11 Section 15.435 to serve the purposes of this subchapter, especially
  12 in connection with projects described by Section 15.434(b);
- [(7) an evaluation of methods for encouraging
  participation in the procurement process by companies domiciled in
  this state or that employ a significant number of residents of this
  state; and
- [(8) an evaluation of the overall operation, function,
  and structure of the fund.
- (h) The advisory committee shall review the overall operation, function, and structure of <u>each fund listed in</u>

  Subsection (g) [the fund] at least semiannually [and may provide comments and recommendations to the board on any matter].
- 23 (i) The advisory committee may:
- 24 (1) provide comments and recommendations to the board 25 on any matter;
- 26 (2) review the overall operation, function, and 27 structure of any fund established under this chapter or Chapter 16

## 1 that is not listed in Subsection (g); and

- 2 (3) adopt rules, procedures, and policies as needed to
- 3 administer this section and implement its responsibilities.
- 4 (j) Chapter 2110, Government Code, does not apply to the
- 5 size, composition, or duration of the advisory committee.
- 6 (k) The advisory committee is subject to Chapter 325,
- 7 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
- 8 as provided by that chapter, the advisory committee is abolished
- 9 and this section expires September 1, 2035.
- 10 (1) As needed, the [The] advisory committee shall make
- 11 recommendations to the board regarding information to be posted on
- 12 the board's Internet website relating to the funds listed in
- 13 <u>Subsection (g)</u> [under Section 15.440(b)].
- 14 (m) The advisory committee shall evaluate and may provide
- 15 comments or recommendations on the feasibility of the state owning,
- 16 constructing, and operating water supply projects, including
- 17 reservoirs and major water supply conveyance infrastructure,
- 18 through existing financial assistance programs under Subchapter E
- 19 of this chapter, Subchapter E or F, Chapter 16, or other mechanisms.
- 20 (n) The executive administrator shall provide an annual
- 21 report to the advisory committee on:
- 22 (1) the board's compliance with statewide annual goals
- 23 relating to historically underutilized businesses; and
- 24 (2) the participation level of historically
- 25 underutilized businesses in projects that receive funding related
- 26 to a bond enhancement agreement under Subchapter G [this
- 27 subchapter].
