## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the procedure for amending or revoking certificates of
- 3 public convenience and necessity issued to certain water utilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.2541, Water Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) As an alternative to decertification or expedited
- 9 release under Section 13.254, the owner of a tract of land that is
- 10 at least 25 acres and that is not receiving water or sewer service
- 11 may petition for expedited release of the area from a certificate of
- 12 public convenience and necessity in the manner provided by this
- 13 section and is entitled to that release if the landowner's property
- 14 is located in a county with a population of at least 1.2 million, a
- 15 county adjacent to a county with a population of at least 1.2
- 16 million, [er] a county with a population of more than 200,000 and
- 17 less than 233,500 that does not contain a public or private
- 18 university that had a total enrollment in the most recent fall
- 19 semester of 40,000 or more, or a county adjacent to a county
- 20 adjacent to a county with a population of at least 1.2 million [and
- 21 not in a county that has a population of more than 50,500 and less
- 22 than 52,000].
- 23 (e-1) A landowner that submits a petition under this section
- 24 may agree to pay to the certificate holder that is the subject of

- 1 the petition under this section an amount equal to the amount
- 2 necessary to pay or defease a federal loan for a certificate holder
- 3 that is a borrower under a federal loan program. On request from
- 4 the petitioner, the certificate holder must provide the petitioner
- 5 with the amount necessary to pay or defease the federal loan. The
- 6 utility commission may issue an order to require the certificate
- 7 holder to accept a loan payment or defeasance under this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 a proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 10 necessity that commences on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 A proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 12 necessity that commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 13 governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding is
- 14 commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
