- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.012(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (b) The commission may set a lower fee or waive the fee or
- 8 license requirement for a resident who is under 17 years old, 65
- 9 years old or older, or participating in an event that is sponsored
- 10 or co-sponsored by the department with the approval of the
- 11 director. The commission shall waive the fee for:
- 12 (1) an honorably discharged veteran of the United
- 13 States armed services who is 65 years old or older;
- 14 (2) a qualified veteran with a disability; and
- 15 (3) [for a resident on active duty as a member of the
- 16 United States military forces, the Texas Army National Guard, the
- 17 Texas Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard.
- SECTION 2. Section 46.004(c), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 (c) The commission shall waive the fee for:
- 21 (1) an honorably discharged veteran of the United
- 22 States armed services who is 65 years old or older;
- 23 (2) a qualified veteran with a disability as defined
- 24 by Section 42.012; and

- (3) [for] a resident on active duty as a member of the
- 2 United States military forces, the Texas Army National Guard, the
- 3 Texas Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 50.002, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 6 (c) The commission shall waive the fee for an annual
- 7 combination hunting and fishing license for an honorably discharged
- 8 veteran of the United States armed services who is 65 years old or
- 9 older.
- 10 SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 11 only to a fee charged for a hunting or fishing license issued on or
- 12 after the effective date of this Act.
- 13 (b) A hunting or fishing license issued before the effective
- 14 date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the license was
- 15 issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 16 The Parks and Wildlife Department is not required to issue a refund
- 17 for any license issued before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
