- 2 relating to a restriction on permits authorizing direct discharges
- 3 of waste or pollutants into water in certain stream segments,
- 4 stream assessment units, and drainage areas.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 26, Water Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 26.0275 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 26.0275. RESTRICTION ON PERMITS FOR DISCHARGES INTO
- 9 CERTAIN SEGMENTS, ASSESSMENT UNITS, AND DRAINAGE AREAS. (a) In
- 10 this section:
- 11 (1) "Assessment unit" has the meaning assigned by the
- 12 commission's Surface Water Quality Monitoring Program as it existed
- 13 <u>on September 1, 2025.</u>
- 14 (2) "Classified segment" means any portion of Devil's
- 15 River identified in Appendices A and C of 30 T.A.C. Section 307.10
- 16 as it existed on September 1, 2025.
- 17 (3) "Drainage area" means any unclassified water body
- 18 that drains to a stream segment or a stream assessment unit to which
- 19 this section applies.
- 20 <u>(4) "Stream assessment unit" means an assessment unit</u>
- 21 for a stream, creek, or river, or a portion of a stream, creek, or
- 22 river, that is located within a classified segment that is not a
- 23 stream segment to which this section applies.
- 24 (5) "Stream segment" means a stream, creek, or river,

- 1 or a portion of a stream, creek, or river, that is a classified
- 2 segment.
- 3 (6) "Unclassified water body" means a water body other
- 4 than a classified segment or an assessment unit located within a
- 5 classified segment.
- 6 (b) This section applies to:
- 7 (1) a stream segment or stream assessment unit that,
- 8 on September 1, 2025, has had:
- 9 (A) at least 10 water quality samples taken from
- 10 the stream segment or stream assessment unit over the 10 calendar
- 11 years preceding January 1, 2024; and
- 12 (B) according to data in the commission's Surface
- 13 Water Quality Monitoring Information System, a total phosphorus
- 14 level below 0.06 milligrams per liter in 90 percent or more of all
- 15 water quality samples taken from the stream segment or stream
- 16 assessment unit over the 10 calendar years preceding January 1,
- 17 2024; and
- 18 (2) the drainage areas of any stream segment or stream
- 19 assessment unit that meets the requirements of Subdivision (1).
- 20 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the commission may
- 21 not issue a new permit authorizing the direct discharge from a
- 22 domestic wastewater treatment facility of any waste, effluent, or
- 23 pollutants into a stream segment, stream assessment unit, or
- 24 drainage area to which this section applies.
- 25 <u>(d) This section does not affect the authority of the</u>
- 26 commission to issue:
- 27 (1) a new or amended permit to a municipality or a

- 1 river authority that authorizes a direct discharge from a domestic
- 2 wastewater treatment facility of waste, effluent, or pollutants
- 3 <u>into a stream segment, stream assessment unit, or drainage area to</u>
- 4 which this section applies;
- 5 (2) an individual permit for a municipal separate
- 6 storm sewer system; or
- 7 (3) a general permit for stormwater and associated
- 8 non-stormwater discharges.
- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to an application for a permit that is submitted to the Texas
- 11 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 12 of this Act. An application for a permit that was submitted to the
- 13 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date
- 14 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 15 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 16 that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
