- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.108, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (c-3) to read as follows:
- 8 (c-3) At the beginning of the school year, a school district

shall provide to the parent or guardian of each student enrolled in

- 10 the district a written copy of the district's procedures in its
- 11 <u>multihazard emergency operations plan</u> involving the care of
- 12 students in the event of an emergency, including:
- 13 <u>(1) a natural disaster;</u>
- 14 (2) a temperature event involving extreme heat or
- 15 cold;

- 16 (3) a power outage affecting food distribution to
- 17 students;
- 18 <u>(4) an active shooter emergency described by</u>
- 19 Subsection (g); and
- 20 <u>(5) a declared emergency in the district or this</u>
- 21 state.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
