Chapter 97, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, 6 Section 97.002 is amended as follows: 7 Sec. 97.002. LIMIT ON LIABILITY OF CERTAIN HIGHWAY, ROAD, 8 AND STREET CONTRACTORS. A contractor who designs, installs, 9 constructs<u>, or repairs, or maintains</u> a highway, road, or street<u>, or</u> 10 11 any devices or systems intended for public safety or traffic 12 management installed thereon, for the Texas Department of Transportation any state, regional, county or local government 13 14 entity, or department thereof, is not liable to a claimant for personal injury, property damage, or death arising from the 15 16 performance of the design, installation, construction, or repair, or maintenance if, at the time of the personal injury, property 17 damage, or death, the contractor is in material compliance with 18 contract documents material to the condition or defect that was the 19 proximate cause of the personal injury, property damage, or death. 20 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
