4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 171.014(d), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(d) The department shall annually review the materials to
8	determine if changes to the contents of the materials are
9	necessary. The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
10	for considering and making changes to the materials, including
11	rules requiring the department to:
12	(1) periodically submit the materials to the American
13	College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists to verify that the
14	materials are medically accurate; and
15	(2) revise the materials to incorporate any
16	recommendations from the American College of Obstetricians and
17	Gynecologists for improving the medical accuracy of the materials.
18	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
19	of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
20	Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement the
21	changes in law made by this Act.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
