- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 8849.151, Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8849.151. [PUMPING] FEES. (a) The district may
- 8 assess <u>production</u> [<u>regulatory pumping</u>] fees <u>under Section</u>
- 9 36.205(c), Water Code, and export fees under Section 36.122, Water
- 10 Code [for water produced in or exported from the district].
- 11 (b) The production [regulatory pumping] fees the district
- 12 assesses for water for crop or livestock production or other
- 13 agricultural uses may not exceed 20 percent of the rate applied to
- 14 water for municipal uses.
- 15 (c) <u>Production</u> [<u>Regulatory pumping</u>] fees [<u>based on the</u>
- 16 amount of water withdrawn from a well] may not exceed:
- 17 (1) \$1 for each acre-foot for water used to irrigate
- 18 agricultural crops; or
- 19 (2) 17 cents for each thousand gallons for water used
- 20 for any other purpose.
- 21 [(d) Combined regulatory pumping fees for production and
- 22 export of water may not exceed 17 cents for each thousand gallons
- 23 for water used.
- 24 SECTION 2. Mitigation payments and fees assessed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act are ratified, confirmed, and validated
- 2 in all respects.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
