Title 5, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Chapter 254 to read as follows: 6 CHAPTER 254. ACCESS BY CERTIFICATED TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDERS 7 TO ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND DISTRIBUTION POLES 8 Sec. 254.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 9 (1) "Certificated telecommunications provider" means 10 a person who has been issued a certificate of convenience and 11 necessity, certificate of operating authority, or service provider 12 certificate of operating authority by the Public Utility Commission 13 of Texas to offer local exchange telephone service or a person who 14 provides voice service. 15 16 (2) "Pole" means a pole carrying distribution lines 17 with a voltage rating no higher than 34.5 kilovolts. 18 (3) "Pole attachment" means an affixture of cables, 19 strands, wires, and associated equipment attached to a pole directly or indirectly or placed in a right-of-way owned or 20 controlled by an electric cooperative. 21 Sec. 254.002. NONDISCRIMINATORY ACCESS. (a) An electric 22 23 cooperative shall provide a certificated telecommunications 24 provider with nondiscriminatory access regarding:
