A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the disclosure by a seller of certain real property to the purchaser of the property of information regarding the process 3 for obtaining a permit from the Texas Commission on Environmental 4 5 Quality for the storage, taking, or diversion of state water. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 5, Property Code, is amended by adding Section 5.0111 to read as follows: 8 9 Sec. 5.0111. SELLER'S NOTICE REGARDING APPROPRIATION OF STATE WATER. A person who sells an interest in real property in 10 this state that contains or is adjacent to state water shall give to 11 the purchaser of the property a written notice that conforms to the 12 standard notice adopted by the Texas Commission on Environmental 13 Quality under Section 11.121, Water Code, relating to the 14 appropriation of state water. 15 SECTION 2. Section 11.121, Water Code, is amended to read as 16 follows: 17 Sec. 11.121. PERMIT REQUIRED; NOTICE TO CERTAIN PURCHASERS 18 OF REAL PROPERTY. (a) Except as provided in Sections 11.1405, 19 11.142, 11.1421, 11.1422, and 18.003, no person may appropriate any 20 state water or begin construction of any work designed for the 21 storage, taking, or diversion of water without first obtaining a 22 23 permit from the commission to make the appropriation. 24 (b) The commission by rule shall adopt a standard notice for

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1	a purchaser of real property that contains or is adjacent to state
2	water. The notice must be designed to inform a purchaser of:
3	(1) the requirements of this section; and
4	(2) the process by which a person may obtain from the
5	commission a permit authorizing the storage, taking, or diversion
6	of state water.
7	SECTION 3. Section 5.0111, Property Code, as added by this
8	Act, applies only to a sale or conveyance of property for which a
9	binding contract is executed on or after January 1, 2026. A sale or
10	conveyance for which a binding contract is executed before that
1 1	late is measured by the last in effect on the late the sentencet is

11 date is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract is 12 executed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 13 purpose.

14 SECTION 4. Not later than December 31, 2025, the Texas 15 Commission on Environmental Quality shall adopt the notice required 16 by Section 11.121, Water Code, as amended by this Act.

17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
