## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the permissible uses of money attributable to the
- 3 historic infrastructure sustainability trust fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 442.0151(b), (f), and (h), Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The historic infrastructure sustainability trust fund
- 8 is created as a trust fund outside the treasury held by the trust
- 9 company and administered by the comptroller as trustee on behalf of
- 10 the people of this state to generate earnings on money in the fund
- 11 for the purpose of maintaining, preserving, rehabilitating,
- 12 <u>improving</u>, and restoring historic sites throughout the state.
- 13 (f) The commission annually may request a distribution from
- 14 the fund in an amount that may not exceed the amount the trust
- 15 company determines is available for distribution in the applicable
- 16 year under Subsection (d). Money distributed from the fund to the
- 17 commission may be used only for the purpose of maintaining,
- 18 preserving, rehabilitating, <u>improving</u>, and restoring state
- 19 historic sites under the control of the commission and for the
- 20 historic courthouse preservation program under Section 442.0081.
- 21 The commission shall allocate at least one-third of each annual
- 22 distribution from the fund under this subsection for the historic
- 23 courthouse preservation program. The commission may not use money
- 24 received from an annual distribution under this subsection to pay

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- 1 salaries, employee benefits, costs associated with employee
- 2 benefits, or administration, operating, or program costs of the
- 3 commission.
- 4 (h) The commission may receive an additional distribution
- 5 from the fund under Subsection (g) only after the commission
- 6 certifies to the Legislative Budget Board that:
- 7 (1) the commission has reviewed and approved the use
- 8 of the money;
- 9 (2) all purchases made with the money will conform to
- 10 any applicable provision of law governing state procurement and
- 11 contracting; and
- 12 (3) the money will not be used to:
- 13 (A) pay salaries, employee benefits, costs
- 14 associated with employee benefits, or administration, operating,
- 15 or program costs of the commission or the state historic sites under
- 16 the control of the commission;
- 17 (B) acquire new historic sites [<del>or real</del>
- 18 property]; or
- 19 (C) purchase capital equipment that is not
- 20 related to the rehabilitation or restoration of a historic site
- 21 under the control of the commission or the historic courthouse
- 22 preservation program under Section 442.0081.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to a distribution from the historic infrastructure sustainability
- 25 trust fund requested by the Texas Historical Commission on or after
- 26 the effective date of this Act.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
