A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the availability and instruction on the use of
- 3 automated external defibrillators and a cardiac emergency response
- 4 plan at public schools and certain private schools in this state.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 22.902(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) Each school nurse, assistant school nurse, athletic
- 9 coach or sponsor, physical education instructor, marching band
- 10 director, cheerleading coach, and any other school employee
- 11 specified by the commissioner and each student who serves as an
- 12 athletic trainer must participate in the instruction in the use of
- 13 an automated external defibrillator. A person described by this
- 14 subsection must receive and maintain certification in the use of an
- 15 automated external defibrillator from the American Heart
- 16 Association, the American Red Cross, or a similar nationally
- 17 recognized, guidelines-based organization focused on emergency
- 18 <u>cardiovascular care</u> [association].
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 38.017(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) Each school district shall make available at each campus
- 22 in the district the number of [at least one] automated external
- 23 defibrillators [defibrillator], as defined by Section 779.001,
- 24 Health and Safety Code, necessary for a defibrillator to be

No. 3485 1 accessible from any location on campus so that a person may provide emergency care to a person in cardiac arrest within three minutes of 2 being notified of a possible medical emergency involving cardiac 3 arrest. A campus defibrillator must be readily available during 4 5 any University Interscholastic League athletic competition held on the campus. In determining the placement of [location at which to 6 store] a campus defibrillator, the principal of the campus shall 7 8 consider the guidelines from the American Heart Association or another organization with expertise in emergency cardiovascular 9 care and ensure that the defibrillator is clearly marked [primary 10 location on campus where students engage in athletic activities]. 11 SECTION 3. Section 38.018, Education Code, is amended to 12 read as follows: 13 Sec. 38.018. [PROCEDURES REGARDING RESPONSE TO] CARDIAC
- 14 15 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN [ARREST]. (a) Each school district and private school shall develop and implement a cardiac emergency 16 17 response plan that establishes safety procedures for a district or school employee or other appropriate personnel [student] to follow 18 19 in responding to a medical emergency involving cardiac arrest on district or school grounds[, including the appropriate response 20 21 time in administering cardiopulmonary resuscitation, using an automated external defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001, 22 Health and Safety Code, or calling a local emergency medical 23 24 services provider].
- 25 (b) In developing the plan, the district or school shall:

 26 (1) work directly with local emergency services

 27 providers to integrate the plan with the providers' protocols; and

- 1 (2) incorporate evidence-based practices, such as the
- 2 American Heart Association's core elements for cardiac emergency
- 3 response plans.
- 4 (c) The plan must include at a minimum:
- 5 (1) the establishment of a cardiac emergency response
- 6 team;
- 7 (2) procedures for activating the cardiac emergency
- 8 response team in response to a medical emergency involving cardiac
- 9 arrest;
- 10 (3) the dissemination of the plan throughout each
- 11 district or school campus;
- 12 (4) ongoing training in first aid, cardiopulmonary
- 13 resuscitation, and the use of automated external defibrillators, as
- 14 defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, using
- 15 evidence-based guidelines, for appropriate district or school
- 16 employees, including school coaches, school nurses, and athletic
- 17 trainers;
- 18 (5) annual practice drills in responding to a medical
- 19 emergency involving cardiac arrest; and
- 20 <u>(6)</u> annual review, evaluation, and, if necessary,
- 21 modification of the plan.
- 22 (d) A private school is required to develop <u>a cardiac</u>
- 23 emergency response plan [safety procedures] under this section only
- 24 if the school receives an automated external defibrillator from the
- 25 agency or receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an
- 26 automated external defibrillator.
- (e) The commissioner shall establish a grant program to

- 1 award grants to districts and schools to assist with the
- 2 implementation of a cardiac emergency response plan. In awarding
- 3 grants, the commissioner shall prioritize districts or schools at
- 4 which at least 50 percent of enrolled students are educationally
- 5 disadvantaged.
- 6 SECTION 4. Not later than the first instructional day of the
- 7 2027-2028 school year, each public school and private school to
- 8 which Sections 38.017 and 38.018, Education Code, as amended by
- 9 this Act, apply shall make available the number of automated
- 10 external defibrillators and implement a cardiac emergency response
- 11 plan as required by those sections.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
