2	relating to the operation of a program by the Texas Department of
3	Transportation to allow a real property owner to plant or replace
4	vegetation in a right-of-way.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 202, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 202.0585 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 202.0585. VEGETATION IN RIGHT-OF-WAY. (a) Subject to
9	Subsections (b) and (c), the department by rule shall develop and
10	implement a program to allow an owner of real property abutting or
11	adjoining property acquired by the department for the right-of-way
12	of a road in the state highway system to:
13	(1) plant vegetation or replace existing vegetation in
14	the right-of-way if the owner determines that the new vegetation

15 will enhance the aesthetic appeal of the property; or

(2) replace existing vegetation in the right-of-way if

- 17 the vegetation to be replaced reduces the visibility of the
- 18 property.

- 19 (b) The program may authorize an owner of real property
- 20 described by Subsection (a) to plant or replace existing vegetation
- 21 only in the right-of-way, including the outer separation, located
- 22 within 500 feet of the property.
- 23 <u>(c) An owner of real property who plants or replaces</u>
- 24 vegetation in the right-of-way in accordance with this section:

- 1 (1) is responsible for all costs associated with the
- 2 planting or replacement of vegetation;
- 3 (2) may use only vegetation adapted to local
- 4 conditions;
- 5 (3) must contract with a landscaping professional
- 6 approved by the department to plant or replace the vegetation; and
- 7 (4) may not interfere with any public utility
- 8 infrastructure located in the right-of-way.
- 9 (d) The rules adopted by the department under Subsection (a)
- 10 may not impair or relinquish the state's right to use the
- 11 right-of-way when needed to construct or reconstruct the road for
- 12 which it was acquired.
- (e) Use by the owner of adjoining or abutting real property
- 14 under this section is not abandonment of the right-of-way by the
- 15 <u>department</u>.
- (f) This section does not require a utility, as defined by
- 17 Section 203.091, that performs work in the right-of-way to replace
- 18 vegetation or provide compensation to an owner of real property for
- 19 replacing vegetation if the removal of vegetation is necessary to
- 20 perform the work.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
