- $[\frac{3}{3}]$ at least 60 percent of the moving image project 22 23 must be filmed in Texas; and
- 24 (3) $[\frac{4}{4}]$ a production company must submit to the

- 1 office an expended budget, in a format prescribed by the office,
- 2 that reflects all in-state spending and includes all receipts,
- 3 invoices, pay orders, and other documentation considered necessary
- 4 by the office to accurately determine the amount of a production
- 5 company's in-state spending that has occurred.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
