- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Parks and Wildlife
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 12.023 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 12.023. NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN STRUCTURES.
- 9 (a) This section applies only in a county with a population of less
- 10 than 500,000 that:
- 11 (1) borders the Gulf of Mexico and in which a national
- 12 wildlife refuge is wholly or partly located; or
- 13 (2) does not contain a municipality with a population
- 14 greater than 300,000 and is adjacent to a county described by
- 15 Subdivision (1).
- 16 (b) Not later than the 90th day before the date a person
- 17 begins construction of a structure taller than 575 feet, the person
- 18 shall submit to the department a request for the department to
- 19 review the project under Section 12.0011(b)(3).
- 20 <u>(c) Not later than the 45th day after the date the</u>
- 21 department receives a request under Subsection (b), the department
- 22 shall recommend in writing measures to minimize the impact of the
- 23 structure on migratory birds.
- 24 (d) If the department does not provide recommendations

- 1 under Subsection (c) to the person who requested review within the
- 2 period required by that subsection, the construction of the project
- 3 may proceed without further delay or modification.
- 4 (e) Not later than the 45th day after the date the person who
- 5 requested review receives the recommendations under Subsection
- 6 (c), the person shall provide a written response to the department
- 7 <u>accepting</u> the <u>recommendations</u> or <u>providing</u> alternative
- 8 minimization measures in place of department recommendations.
- 9 (f) If the department does not agree to the alternative
- 10 minimization measures received under Subsection (e), the
- 11 department shall reach a final decision on the minimization
- 12 measures the structure must utilize not later than the 45th day
- 13 after the date the department received the alternative minimization
- 14 measures. If the department requires compliance with minimization
- 15 measures other than those agreed to by the person who requested
- 16 review, the person is entitled to an administrative hearing before
- 17 the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 18 (g) The commission may adopt rules to implement this
- 19 section.
- 20 (h) Information submitted to the department under this
- 21 <u>section is not subject to Chapter 552, Government Code.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 12.023, Parks and Wildlife Code, as
- 23 added by this Act, applies only to a person who begins construction
- 24 of a structure on or after the 90th day after the effective date of
- 25 this Act.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
