Section 253.001(4), Health and Safety Code, as amended by Chapters 674 (H.B. 1009) and 887 (H.B. 4696), Acts of the 7 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, is reenacted and amended 8 to read as follows: 9 (4) "Facility" means: 10 11 (A) а nursing facility licensed by the 12 commission under Chapter 242; 13 (B) intermediate care an facility for 14 individuals with an intellectual disability licensed by the commission under Chapter 252; 15 an adult foster care provider that contracts 16 (C) with the commission; 17 18 (D) a home and community support services agency licensed by the commission under Chapter 142; 19 20 (E) a prescribed pediatric extended care center 21 licensed by the commission under Chapter 248A; 22 (F) an assisted living facility licensed by the 23 commission under Chapter 247; (F-1) a facility licensed under Chapter 555; 24

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(F-2) a facility licensed under Chapter 577; 1 2 a day activity and health services facility (G) licensed by the commission under Chapter 103, Human Resources Code; 3 4 (H) a residential child-care facility as defined 5 by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code, at which an elderly person or an adult with a disability resides or is in the facility's care; 6 7 (I) provider who provides а home and 8 community-based services under the home and community-based services (HCS) waiver program or the Texas home living (TxHmL) 9 10 waiver program; or (J) a facility that is exempt from licensure 11 under Section 252.003. 12 SECTION 2. Section 577.004(d), Health and Safety Code, is 13 14 amended to read as follows: 15 (d) The application must contain: 16 (1) the name and location of the mental hospital or 17 mental health facility; the name and address of the physician to be in 18 (2) charge of the hospital care and treatment of the patients; 19 (3) the names and addresses of the mental hospital 20 21 owners, including the officers, directors, and principal stockholders if the owner is a corporation or other association, or 22 the names and addresses of the members of the board of trustees of 23 24 the community center or the directors of the entity designated by the department to provide mental health services; 25 26 (4) the bed capacity to be authorized by the license; 27 (5) the number, duties, and qualifications of the

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professional staff; 1 2 (6) a description of the equipment and facilities of 3 the mental hospital or mental health facility; [and] 4 (7) the name and address of the person responsible for the daily operations of the mental hospital or mental health 5 6 facility; and 7 (8) other information required by the department, including affirmative evidence of ability to comply with the 8 department's rules and standards. 9

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
