1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-18 AN ACT

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relating to public hearing requirements for issuing a license for or expanding certain residential child-care facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 42.0461(a), Human Resources Code, amended to read as follows:

- (a) Before the commission [department] may issue a license or certificate for the operation or the expansion of the capacity of a general residential operation, a cottage home operation, or a continuum-of-care residential operation that is located in a county with a population of less than 500,000 [300,000], the applicant for the license, certificate, or expansion shall, at the applicant's expense:
- (1) conduct a public hearing on the application in accordance with <u>commission</u> [department] rules after notifying the <u>commission</u> [department] of the date, time, and location of the hearing; and
- 1-35 (2) publish notice of the application in a newspaper 1-36 of general circulation in the community in which the child-care services are proposed to be provided.
